Instructions for Virtual Oral Presentations

- 1. Your pre-recorded video presentation will be live streamed at scheduled times.
- 2. An online workshop will be held on 27th October 2021 from 6 pm to 7 pm to provide guidelines on recording your presentation as a video.
- 3. Your presentation time is 12 minutes which is followed by a 3-minute Q&A session live.
- 4. You may use MS Power Point to prepare the presentation. You need to provide a 12-minute prerecorded video presentation. More details will be provided for you during the workshop. A sample 12-minute pre-recorded video presentation will be provided for you.
- 5. <u>The pre-recorded 12-minute video presentation and the power point presentation should be sent to</u> the Congress Office (congress@pgia.ac.lk) by November 9th, 2021.
- 6. Your video-presentation will be evaluated on technical content, as well as presentation skills by a panel of judges.
- 7. The presenter (1st author) should attend the on-line oral presentation session for a Q&A session after the video presentation (time and date will be notified in due course).

Note: Full papers of all oral presentations made at the Congress-2021 will be considered for publication in one of the four Issues of the journal "Tropical Agricultural Research, Vol. 33, 2021".
