Instructions for Virtual Poster Presentations

- 1. Your poster will be live streamed at a given time slot during the online poster presentation session.
- 2. An online workshop will be held on 27th October 2021 from 7 pm to 8 pm to provide guidelines on poster preparation and video recording.
- 3. You may use software such as MS Power Point or Corel Draw to prepare the poster. You need to provide a 2-minute pre-recorded video presentation regarding your poster. More details will be provided for you during the workshop. A sample 2-minute pre-recorded video presentation will be provided for you.
- 4. The size of the poster should be 56" (width) and 36" (height) and in **landscape orientation**. The title, author/s and their affiliations should be indicated on the top of the poster.
- 5. The data should be presented in a logical and self-explanatory sequence. A sample poster is given below for your information.
- 6. <u>Posters (PDF file and 2-minute pre-recorded video presentation) should be sent to the PGIA</u> <u>Congress Office (congress@pgia.ac.lk) by November 9th, 2021.</u>
- 7. Your poster will be evaluated on technical content, organization of work and visual impact by a panel of judges.
- 8. The poster presenter (1st author) should attend the on-line session for poster presentations for a Q&A session (time and date will be notified in due course).

Note: Full papers of all the posters presented at the PGIA Congress - 2021 will be considered for publication in one of the four Issues of the journal "Tropical Agricultural Research, Vol. 33, 2021".
