## **Job Description**

#### Job Overview:

The Research Associate/Coordinator will provide program coordination, research, and communication support for the research project **Gendering Water and Climate Science Research in South Asia** (*Project summary and consortium details are provided in the annexure*) funded by the International Development Research Centre, Canada and will be based in the Post Graduate Institute of Agriculture, University of Peradeniya (PGIA - Sri Lanka). The post-holder will be responsible for supporting the Project Lead on all facets of project delivery and supporting the research team to conduct a series of qualitative studies in the field of improving gender analysis and larger interdisciplinary (STEM) research and practice in Water and Climate Science (WCS), including identifying and involving research participants/respondents, ensuring their consent for participation and the collection, management, and analysis of qualitative research data through in-depth interviews. The post-holder will be expected to provide support with the planning and facilitating of training and workshops for SAWA fellows and stakeholder meetings.

## **Key Responsibilities:**

#### Support in Project coordination/ administration

- To support Project Lead on all facets of project delivery including progress reporting for the funder.
- Attendance and documentation of all coordination and management-level meetings of the project.
- Regularly communicate the project status to the Project Lead and the regional research and training coordinator.
- Ensure compliance with the committed timeline and workplan of the project.
- Planning and facilitation of stakeholder meetings/workshop including preparation of letter of invites and helping with other logistics arrangements.

- Supporting the postgraduate students working under the project and help in their field work and activities.
- Supporting all other research work of the project.
- Help out with the website content and updating content in coordination with the regional research lead and regional research and training coordinator.
- Handling social media and posting project-related information regularly.
